RUBC is a private postsecondary institution granted institutional approval by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE) pursuant to California Education Code Section 94915. Our programs are approved by the California Board of Barbering & Cosmetology, and the institution is accredited by the National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts & Sciences (NACCAS). BPPE approval means the institution and its operation comply with minimum state standards and does not imply endorsement or recommendation by the State or the Bureau. Accreditation and approval status of individual campuses may vary; current status is stated in our School Catalog.
